Since its establishment in 2000, CARAM Cambodia primarily works with Cambodian and Vietnamese migrant sex workers in Cambodia as well as with Cambodian migrant workers who are preparing to migrate abroad. CARAM Cambodia's main work include: safe repatriation and reintegration assistance for victims of trafficking and labor exploitation; outreach education to both Cambodian and Vietnamese migrant sex workers on reproductive health and human rights; pre-departure training to Cambodian migrant workers; and advocacy.

Vision

CARAM Cambodia envisions that "all people have the rights to stay or move and live and work in dignity with equal rights in society where their quality of life is ensured".

- ✦ The empowerment of migrants, their families and communities in the migration process for the promotion and protection of human rights, including health, reproductive and sexual rights.
- ✦ The production of knowledge using participatory action research on vulnerability, health status and potential of migrant workers for planning and implementing appropriate and effective regional interventions and advocacy work.
- ✦ The mainstreaming of migration and HIV/AIDS from the migrant perspective as specific areas of intervention in policy and program development.
- ✦ Advocacy for improvement of quality of life of migrant workers including proper and equal access to health care and services.
- ✦ Promotion of gender equality and justice.

Main Activities of CARAM Cambodia

➔ Official Pre-departure Training Program

CARAM Cambodia provides Pre-departure Training Program to Cambodian migrant workers to ensure that they could receive safe migration.



➔ Communities Based Prevention, Care and Right for Migrant Workers

Cambodian and Vietnamese construction and entertainment migrant workers has been provided with outreach program on HIV/AIDS, reproductive health, basic human rights related to health to ensure that they can access to social and legal support.



➔ Participatory Action Research

Participatory Action Research has been conducted to identify problems faced by migrant workers for program intervention and advocacy to change situation of migrant workers.

➔ Regional Coordination

To ensure migrant workers' right are promoted and protected, CARAM Cambodia has cooperated with Task Force on ASEAN Migrant Workers, CARAM Asia, Mekong Migration Network and other regional networks to host any consultation, campaign, workshop, conference to find mechanism or develop framework on promotion and protection of migrant workers and also share information on situation of migrant workers.



➔ Advocacy, Networking and Partnership

Advocacy activities such as face to face meeting, radio talk show, roundtable discussion, press media, consultation, public forum, international Migrant Day, etc... have been conducted to improve and change situation of migrant workers.

➔ Repatriation and Support

In order to promote and protect migrant workers, CARAM Cambodia has collaborated with NGOs partners and some key stakeholders in destination countries to safely repatriate migrant workers who were exploited or trafficked in destination countries to countries of origins so as to reintegrate into their communities and rehabilitate them.

➔ Legal Support Program

To promote and protect the right of migrant workers, CARAM Cambodia provides Legal Support to migrant workers to ensure they have access to justice.
